



CHRISTMAS RECYCLING

Blue Bag

You can recycle your **Christmas Cards** as long as they have no glitter, plastic or non-card items attached by putting them in your blue bag along with **white** and **brown envelopes, catalogues, newspapers, magazines & other paper.**



Cardboard Boxes can also be put in your blue bag, if they are too big please flatten and place securely under your blue bag or blue box.

You can also use your blue bag to recycle your empty food and drinks **cans.**

Use your blue box to recycle all your **glass bottles and jars.**



Recycling Sites

You can take cans, plastic, paper, glass, textiles, books and beverage cartons to one of the Council's recycling sites.

Put your Christmas dinner vegetable peelings to good use and compost them by putting them in your green bin or home compost bin.

Christmas Trees

If your property is on a garden waste collection round please put your Christmas tree at the edge of your property by 7am on your "green" collection day. You do not need a green wheeled bin just put your tree out on the correct day between Tuesday 3 and Friday 27 January 2012.

No trees over 5ft please. If your tree is taller than this please chop it accordingly before placing it out for collection.

If your property is not on a garden waste collection round you can take your tree to one of the following household waste recycling centres:

- Harrison Way, Northwood, Darley Dale (DE4 2LF)
- Mayfield Road, Ashbourne (DE6 2BJ)
- Stonegravels, Chesterfield (S41 7LF)
- Waterswallows, Buxton (SK17 7BJ)
