## Crime Prevention Advice

Layers of security, using a number of physical and electronic crime prevention devices will provide the most effective deterrent. These devices will help to prevent the theft, or slow down the thieves and increase the chances of being caught.

**Some options, including examples of manufacturers, are as follows:**

- I** Have a hidden battery isolation or fuel cut off switch custom fitted to your vehicle. Simple but can be disproportionately effective
- I** Use chemically coded UV property identification fluid in carefully selected positions to mark body panels/VIN plate/ECU etc. Advertise the use of this system using window stickers (SelectaDNA, Smartwater)
- I** Datatag produce a Thatcham approved marking system. This uses a similar covert and coded UV fluid but adds concealed transponders, tags and comprehensive UV etching.
- I** Restrict access to your vehicle. A properly installed driveway security post can be an extremely effective deterrent. (ATG, Autopa etc.)
- I** Fit a wheel clamp (eg. Bulldog Security Products)
- I** Use a full steering wheel lock (Disklok) Consider a foot pedal lock, ensuring it is properly fitted. (eg. Clutch Claw\* or similar)
- I** Consider installing a clutch Mech Lock\*. This is a one way valve that locks the clutch open, disengaging the gearbox from the engine.
- I** Use a ground anchor (eg. PJB Security Products, Abus) with a heavy duty chain (English Chain Company, Pragmasis) and padlock (Mul-T-Lock etc.)
- I** Fit a Thatcham approved car alarm that incorporates an electronic immobiliser and preferably tilt detection and perimeter security. An auto-dialler function will contact a pre-programmed phone number to alert you if the alarm is activated.
- I** Install a vehicle tracking system. (Tracker and others). Some products incorporate remote vehicle management functions. 'Home made' devices using mobile phone cards can be effective but are relatively easy to block.

This list is not exhaustive and there are other options available. Any device used should preferably be one that has been approved following independent testing by the likes of Thatcham, Sold Secure or Secured by Design. \* These products have not been independently tested.
